#### **Eligibility & Admission Criteria for Diploma in Sports Coaching**

#### **(For the Academic Year 2020-2021)**

#### **Admission Procedure**

1. Eligible candidates desirous to seek admission to Diploma in Sports Coaching should apply online before the last date prescribed in the Notification for the same.
2. Eligible candidates shall be called for online admission tests on the basis of the documents submitted by them.
3. Candidates must be in possession of all Original Certificates/ Credentials and other documents for verification by the respective Academics centres at the time of Joining.
4. The Candidates should indicate preferences with respect to SAI academic centres to which they are desirous of taking admission while filling out the application form. However, final allocation of seat in the academic centre will be decided basis the overall merit secured by the candidate.

### **Allotment of Marks for Admission Criteria:**

- 1) The final selection of candidates (subjected to medical fitness\*) shall be based on a merit list based on marks achieved in accordance with the following criteria:

***\*Physical and Medical Fitness: All Candidates shortlisted provisionally are to undergo the Physical and medical fitness tests as per the prescribed format.***

### **Syllabus for online admission test**

- A) Specialised Sport theory Test - Basic terminology, abbreviation, technical rules, specification of play fields/courts/arena/equipment and competition format.
- B) General knowledge - current affairs, basic sports awareness at national and international level, awards, rural sports in the country and sports promotional schemes.
- C) Logical reasoning and coaching aptitude - Numerical, relationship, sequential, diagrammatic, reasoning pattern of intermediate standard. Fault finding, problem solving and analytical aptitude.
- D) Language and communication test - Grammar, comprehensive, synonyms, antonyms of matric standard in both Hindi and English.
- E) Basic computer knowledge - Basic knowledge of Microsoft office and excel, terminology of computer and internet.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

2) The eligibility criteria for applying for the Diploma in Sports Coaching Course is covered in succeeding paragraphs.

### **A) Educational qualifications and Sports achievements.**

Note :

(1) In addition to the number of vacancies advertised in admission brochure against each sport discipline, two Supernumerary vacancy (one for men and one for women) have been created for candidates in category A(I) in each sport discipline. Physical and Medical Tests will be applicable as to other candidates.

(2) In case of more than one candidate in one sport discipline, Candidates will be selected on the basis of ranking as follows:-

- a. First: Medal in Olympics.
- b. Second: Medal in Senior World Championships.
- c. Third: Participation in Olympics.
- d. Fourth: Gold Medal in Asian/Commonwealth Games

(3) In case of Score tie (within the same gender group), admission will be given to the candidates who is elder in age.

(4) Rest of the eligible candidates in this category have to undergo the entire selection process based on merit as applicable to candidates in other category.

(5) In case of vacancy falling short due to non availability of candidate in any sport discipline, the vacancy assigned to that sport can be diverted to other sport disciplines if requirement so exists. The diversion of vacancies from one sport to other will be finalised by a Committee Chaired by Senior ED (Academics)NSNIS, Patiala.

**B) Age Limit :** The age limit for applicants for the Course shall be 21-35 years. Relaxation in Upper age limit up to Five years shall be given to:

- i) The candidates who have participated in Olympics Games/ Senior World Championships/ Asian Games/ Senior Asian Championships/Commonwealth Games/Senior Commonwealth Championships.
- ii) The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category.
- iii) In Service and Ex-service candidates from Armed Forces of India.
