ADVERTISEMENT FOR HIRING OF FOREIGN COACHES

The National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) invites applications from highly qualified and experienced Foreign Coaches to train the Indian Shooting Team/National Squad for achieving excellence in all major International Competitions including Olympic Games 2024.

The appointment of foreign coaches is subject to approval by the Sports Authority of India (SAI) on contractual basis and as per remuneration under SAI norms for the disciplines as below:

VACANCY

Rifle - 1

Pistol - 1

Shotgun Trap -1

Shotgun Skeet - 1

QUALIFICATION

- Should be able to communicate in English
- Should be physically fit
- Should be below 65 years of age. However, in exceptional cases, the National Rifle Association of India may take a decision based on the credentials of the coach, if age exceeds 65 years.

EXPERIENCE

- Should have played Olympic Games/Continental Games/Commonwealth Game/World Championships or Continental Championships.
- Should have trained the Junior or Senior National teams of any country for at least 3 years.
- Medal winning athletes coached at the level of Olympic Games/Continental Games/Commonwealth Games/World Championships or Continental Championships will have added weightage.

TENURE

The tenure of the contract will be till Olympic Games 2024 from the date of appointment.

SCOPE OF WORK

- To layout the training program, known as Athlete Development Charter, in consultation with High Performance Manager/Section Head Coach & Secretary General NRAI. This program should include technical, physical and mental training program.
- The Coach would be given specific task/targets to be achieved during the period of the contract. This includes seniors/juniors/youth category shooters.
- The Coach is required to provide his/her services at any place in India where so required by the NRAI and shall perform his/her duties, tasks and responsibilities as assigned to him/her by NRAI to the satisfaction and in accordance with the directions of NRAI.
- The Coach would be required to submit data analysis of all National campers/probable on regular basis as decided by NRAI.
- The services of the coach can also be utilized for conducting Workshops/Clinics-practical training courses for Indian Coaches/Referees/Judges/shooters for promotion of the sport.
