Minutes of the 30th Departmental Project Approval Committee (DPAC) meeting held on 29.10.2021

The 30th meeting of the DPAC was held on 29.10.2021 at 12.00 noon under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Sports).

The list of participants is placed at Annexure -1.

Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the DPAC minutes held on 23.09.2021

The minutes of the 29th DPAC were confirmed.

Agenda No. 2: ATR on the minutes of the meeting on 23.09,2021

The ATR for 29th DPAC was noted with the following observation:

During the last meeting, JS&FA observed that a mechanism is to be evolved to monitor and evaluate the funds already released for KIC and to present status report of the already sanctioned KICs. A status report of 360 Khelo India Centre's already approved, prior to 29th DPAC, shall be circulated to the members immediately.

Agenda No. 3: Proposal for hosting U-21 Khelo India Women Hockey League from Hockey India under Khelo India Scheme

The proposal was examined in detail. Earlier, Rs 32,80,000/- was sanctioned by the DPAC held on 20.02.2020 for the conduct of U21 Women's Hockey league (which could not be held due to COVID). It is decided that the expenditure on fixed cost and variable cost for the present proposal shall also be restricted to the same amount (i.e. Rs. 32,80,000/-). However, in addition, a sum of Rs.15 lakhs is approved as prize money as proposed in the agenda.

DPAC also observed that since the financial assistance is provided under the KI scheme, it is to be ensured by SAI that 50% of the branding of the Hockey league at various venues / platforms shall be reserved for Khelo India and the Khelo India logo shall be prominently displayed.

Agenda No. 4: Adoption of Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) in Uttarakhand

Under this vertical, one of the best existing training centre/academy of the State Govt. is designated as Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE). So far 27 centres in 26 states/UTs have been designated as KISCE. The question was raised as to why there is a proposal to just designate the centre as KISCE as there is no financial proposal attached to the same.

It was explained that the state at times sends more than one proposal despite clear guidelines to send proposal in respect of one training centre. Moreover, such training centres cater to many sports disciplines. Our support to the state under this vertical is generally in respect of sports

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science (across the sports disciplines) & sports specific support to priority sports disciplines for excellence in Olympics. [States were also asked to identify three sports disciplines out of 14 identified by SAI for excellence in Olympics]. Hence, as per the existing procedure, a centre is first designated as State Centre of Excellence and priority sports are notified for support. Subsequently, Khelo India team in consultation with the state govt carries out detailed gap analysis. Post such a detailed analysis, the fund requirement (recurring and non-recurring component) is prepared and once again placed before DPAC for approval.

Secretary (Sports) directed that existing guidelines may be analyzed and if there is any deviation of existing practice vis a vis guidelines, the amendment may be brought in the next DPAC meeting. Moreover, the guidelines formed for obtaining the proposal and subsequent detailed gap analysis shall be circulated to all the members of the DPAC.

Accordingly, proposal to adopt Maharana Pratap Sports College Centre as Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) for Athletics, Boxing & Badminton in Uttarakhand is approved as proposed.

Agenda No. 5: Opening of District Wise Khelo India Centres in Himachal Pradesh, Telangana, Madhya Pradesh and Assam

The proposal for opening 63 KICs is approved with the following observation:

In future, agenda shall be placed before the DPAC with clarity, depicting the points such as the sponsoring agency (District Administration or State Govt.), ownership of the centre, discipline identified etc. in a tabular form.

Agenda No. 6: Grant of Out-of-Pocket Allowances (OPA) to the Khelo India Athletes of Indigenous Games (04) for the F.Y. 2021-22.

DPAC ratified the post facto payment of Rs. 84,90,000/- as OPA which was already released for the 1st quarter of 2021-22.

Proposal for extending the benefit of OPA for the remaining 3 quarters is deferred.

Agenda No. 7: Approval of Funds for Project Management Unit for the period of 1st November, 2021 – 21st Jan 2022

The proposal is deferred.

In the concluding remarks, Chairman, DPAC observed the following:

DPAC shall be held normally once in a month for which notice and agenda may be made available to the members a week in advance and the meeting to be held after sufficient discussion at various levels.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
