#### Detailed Description of Agenda:

The Khelo India Centre (KIC) component under the Khelo India Scheme has twin objectives:

- Providing sports training/coaching to willing children
- Providing a sustainable source of livelihood outside the government set-up to past champion athletes.

KICs are expected to be nurseries for sports talent, the progression of athletes to SAI Training Centres (STCs), National Centres of Excellence (NCOEs), Khelo India State Centres of Excellence (KISCE), states managed academies, private academies, participation of athletes in Khelo India Youth Games and other similar parameters would be utilised to analyse the performance of KICs. It is pertinent to conduct capacity-building exercises to empower the Past Champion Athletes to achieve this. The capacity-building exercise would help Past Champion Athletes (PCAs) inculcate correct techniques at the grassroots level. *In this regard, reference is drawn to clause no. I (iv) under section 1.3.3 on page number 07 of the Khelo India Gazette notification, where-in it is mentioned that capacity building and viability gap support will be provisioned for State Centres of Excellence and Khelo India Centres.*

As of now, around 700 PCAs have been hired across the country. Of 700 hired PCAs, 205 PCAs need a refresher course, which is 30 % of hired PCAs. Assuming this ratio, the following budget is proposed for the capacity building of 1067 PCAs (1000 KICs, including new and converted KICs).



The 41<sup>st</sup> meeting of the DPAC was held on 06.10.2023 at 11:30 am under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Sports) Govt. of India.

2.	Action Taken report on 40th meeting of DPAC held on 23.08.2023	Confirmed. With respect to Item No. 3, DPAC observed the following:  i. It was observed that there has been less registration so far for the Fit India Quiz, hence it was decided that government schools (both Central and State) may be exempted from the requirement of paying registration fees to encourage wider participation and more registration. Approval of chairman may be sought at once on this recommendation.
3.	Engagement of 100 Professionals for implementation & monitoring of Khelo India scheme	DPAC approved Rs. 10 crore for a maximum of 100 resources for a period upto 31.03.2026.  The modalities and process of engaging 100 resources may be finalized at the level of DG SAI.
4.	Capacity Building of Past Champion Athletes (PCAs) hired in Khelo India Centres (KICs)	DPAC approved the proposal with a direction to place the proposal to waive-off the course fee for refresher & certificate course before the Governing Body of SAI. Accordingly, Rs. 57.61 lakh. has been approved for 1,067 PCA towards travelling, lodging & boarding cost. Further, on the basis of similar norms the capacity building program may be conducted for another 250 PCAs for the 250 KICs to be set up, as and when they are engaged and the same shall be placed before DPAC for information.
5.	Viability Gap Funding (VGF) for Khelo India State Centre of Excellence (KISCE) in the State/UT of Bihar	The Proposal was approved with the observation that the funds shall be released on the basis of progress in implementation.

**Agenda Item No.3**

**Engagement of National Testing Agency (NTA) for the conduct of Preliminary Round of Fit India Quiz 2023**

It was observed that three editions of the Fit India Quiz have been undertaken and several learnings are available from these. Therefore, a review of the entire Quiz vertical, especially in terms of issues pertaining to the registration of school children for the quiz and the consequent pricing/cost issues may be undertaken in the near future and the learnings should be converted into concrete proposals for consideration of the authorities, much in advance for the next edition (preferably by June, 2024) so that the next edition of the Fit India Quiz is based on the experience of the earlier editions.

The Committee concurred with the proposal and recommended it to be placed before the GB for approval.

**Agenda Item No.4**

**Capacity Building of Past Champion Athletes (PCAs) hired in Khelo India Centres (KICs)**

It was observed that the proposal to build the capacity of the PCAs hired under the KICs is one of the important innovative measures under this vertical of the Khelo India Scheme. It was reported by ED (Finance), SAI that at the 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Khelo India DPAC held on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2020, it was decided that 90 Extension Centres of SAI STC may be converted into the KICs. These KICs (converted from Extension Centres of SAI STCs) have a total of 96 PCAs under them. Moreover, in the 35<sup>th</sup> DPAC held on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022, it was decided to establish 76 KICs in collaboration of the Indian Railways for which 85 PCAs are to be inducted. Based on the above two developments, the distribution of KIC and PCAs is as given below:

Further to the above, as decided at the 41<sup>st</sup> DPAC held on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023, while 70% of the PCAs would go for a 6-week certificate course, 30% of them would need a refresher course and accordingly, the following table indicates the proposals of the course to be provided for the PCAs:

Based on the above details, the Finance Committee recommended that the training of the PCAs would be held as per the actuals and not more than 1295 PCAs would be trained. It was also made clear by the Committee that training would be held of only those PCAs who have been duly appointed and are already working at the KICs.

The maximum expenditure towards this is proposed to be Rs 3,24,53,800/- which shall not be exceeded.

The above proposal was concurred with and recommended to be placed before the GB for its approval.

**Additional Item No.1**

**Engagement of an Event Management Agency for Accommodation, Catering & Transportation (ACT) services and ACT Management of 1<sup>st</sup> Khelo India Para Games, Delhi 2023**

The first Khelo India Para Games, (KIPG 2023) are being conducted from 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> December 2023, across three SAI Stadias in Delhi, namely, Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium (JNS), Indira Gandhi Stadium (IGS) and Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges (KSSR). The Games are expected to attract a total of 2691 participants, including 1455 athletes. It is envisaged to conduct the Games at par with the international standards.

Accordingly, an RFP was floated on GeM portal on 20.10.2023 with the cost estimate of Rs. 6,07,00,000. In response to the RFP, one bid was received from M/s OYO Hotels and Homes Pvt. Ltd.

The Technical Bid Evaluation Committee found the bid of M/s OYO Hotels and Homes Pvt. Ltd. as technically qualified and recommended to open the financial bid of M/s OYO Hotels and Homes Pvt. Ltd.

The estimated price and rate quoted by the bidder and variation with estimated price is as follows:

Subsequently, the bidder was called for negotiation and the matter was deliberated upon in detail, based on which the revised proposal was received from the bidder through email on 21.11.2023. A comparison of the revised rates with the estimated cost and initial quoted rate is presented below:



In the above context, it is noted that initially the RFP for Engagement of an Event Management Agency for the ACT Management of the 1<sup>st</sup> Khelo India Para Games, Delhi 2023, was prepared with a total estimated cost of INR 9 Cr inclusive of GST, however the overall estimated cost was reduced without the commensurate reduction in scope. In this regard, it is pertinent to note that initially the budget prepared for KIPG was Rs 34 crore, including Rs 9 crore towards ACT but since the budget approved by DPAC for KIPG was only for Rs 20 crore, which included Rs 6.07 crore for the ACT component.

The Committee observed that the revised rate quoted by the firm is 81.18% higher than the estimated cost, and also noted that it is a resultant single tender and there is a lack of competition. Further, the estimated cost is reduced to the value of Rs.6.07 Cr due to reduction of overall budget of the Para Games from Rs. 34 Cr to Rs.20 Cr., without commensurate reduction in scope of work in the RFP.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that this case should be re-tendered with shorter opening time as the Games are less than three weeks away (i.e.10<sup>th</sup> of December 2023). The Committee further directed that fresh estimation of this ACT outsourcing work should be done, keeping in view the special needs of Para Athletes, location and the present market situation.

- 2.1 Lodging and Boarding Cost for 01 week (for those PCAs attending 03 Weeks Refresher Course) and for 02 weeks (for those PCAs attending 06 Week Certification Course) – to be borne by SAI
- 2.2 Course Fee (Nil) – PCAs need not pay any sort of course fees – to be borne by SAI.
- 2.3 Travel Allowance (TA) would be applicable from the place of KIC to the designated Course Centre (to and fro). The reimbursement of Travelling Allowance would be restricted to 3-AC railway booking .

3. The bills and vouchers for the purpose of reimbursement for travel allowance is to be submitted to SAI Regional Centres (RCs) through the States/UTs Sports Department.

Reference is drawn to **sub clause IV of para 1.3.4 of Gazette Notification** of Khelo India Scheme dated 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022 which provides for institutionalizing and funding **Fit India Quizzes and related activities with commensurate price money awards** under the Fit India Moment Component.

In pursuance of above, Fit India Quiz was launched in 2021 as a part of commemorating ‘Azadi Ka Amrit Mohotsav’, it was envisaged to propagate the message of Fit India among the school children and strengthen its presence in schools, a Fit India Quiz has been envisioned to involve school children across the country. Fit India Quiz is dedicated to the school students where students with interest in sports and fitness can participate and compete at state and national level. FIT India Quiz comprised of preliminary rounds, state level rounds and national rounds, thus making it one of the most comprehensive and flagship quiz programs on fitness and sports in the country. In the **first edition of Fit India Quiz, 36,299 students from 13,502 school participated** and showcased their knowledge in fitness and sports.

In the second edition of **Fit India Quiz, 61,981 students from 16,702 school participated** in the mobile based Preliminary Round which was conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) which was held on 08th December and 09th December 2022. Post preliminary rounds, 348 schools were selected, which subsequently competed in 120 web rounds and 36 State and UT winners were identified. The 36 State and UT Champions thereafter competed in the National Finals and the National Champions of the Fit India Quiz 2022 were identified. The Fit India Quiz National Rounds were recorded at STAR TV studios from 23rd July to 31st July 2023 in Mumbai. The 13 episodes of National Finals are being telecasted on Star Sports and Hotstar starting from 12<sup>th</sup> August 2023.

As Fit India Quiz has become a popular mechanism to align the kids across the country to join this mission of fitness and adopt the fit lifestyle. Hence it has been decided to have the third edition of Fit India Quiz with its launch on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2023 with an endeavor to reach out to higher number of schools with greater participation from every state and district of the country. Following sub-agendas under Fit India Quiz are proposed for approval:

#### **i. Structure of Fit India Quiz:**

Fit India Quiz shall comprise of school round (registration), preliminary rounds, state rounds and national rounds, thus making it one of the most comprehensive and flagship quiz programs on fitness and sports in the country. The brief description of the 4 rounds is provided below:

- a. **School Registration:** To be conducted by the school to select students for registration in the Fit India Quiz Preliminary Round. It is the responsibility of the school that they encourage maximum students to participate in the Fit India Quiz 2023.
- b. **Preliminary Round:** To be a multiple-choice mobile based online round conducted by the National Testing Agency (India's premiere examination body that conducts national-level exams such as JEE and NEET). The country-wide quiz will be organized in 13 languages for benefit of students studying in regional-medium schools.
- c. **State Round:** Schools selected in the preliminary round in the state/UT merit list to compete for state/UT championship through series of web rounds. For each state/UT, a specific number of schools to be selected in proportion to the number of schools participating in the preliminary rounds from the state/UT (Refer Annexure I). The state/UT rounds comprising quarter finals, semi-finals and finals to be conducted on a customized web platform and each round to be hosted by a professional quiz master. A dedicated agency to be hired through public procurement to conduct the state/UT rounds.
- d. **National Round:** National round in which the winning team of each State/UT will participate and compete for the Champion's title of FIT INDIA QUIZ 2023. First Runner Up and Second Runner Up prizes will also be decided. This will be a grand event to be hosted by a Celebrity Quiz Master. The series for National Rounds to be produced and telecasted on national TV.

The detailed Fit India Quiz 2023 structure is provided at Annexure-I.

In this context, after due deliberation, it has been proposed to initiate the registration for the third edition of Fit India Quiz on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2023 to 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 and reaching out to higher number of schools, envisioning greater participation from every state and district from the country.

The estimated budget for the Fit India Quiz 2023 is as below:

## ii. Engaging National Testing Agency for Fit India Quiz 2023 registration and conducting preliminary rounds

As in the earlier two editions, in order to maintain the fairness in the examination process and strengthen the credibility of Fit India Quiz, the National Testing Agency (NTA) is to be engaged on nomination basis in accordance with the GFR - rule number 194.

In the first edition of Fit India Quiz 2021, National Testing Agency was engaged for registration and conducting preliminary round in the first edition of Fit India Quiz at the per student fees of Rs 50/-. In the first edition of Fit India Quiz, the registration fees for first 2 students from each school was waived off and was borne by the Fit India Mission. School registering more than 2 students, had to pay the registration fees of Rs 50 per students for over and above 2 students registering for Fit India Quiz.

In the 2nd edition of Fit India Quiz 2022, the NTA was entrusted to conduct the Preliminary Round. The NTA agreed to conduct the preliminary round for Fit India Quiz 2022. The National Testing Agency proposed to complete the registration and examination at a per-student cost of Rs 70/- (Rupees Seventy Only) where Rs.50/- (Rupees Fifty Only) was collected from the students

directly through the payment gateway of NTA and the rest Rs 20/- (Rupees Twenty Only) was borne by Fit India Mission.

Based on the successful and credible execution of first and second edition of Fit India Quiz, it is proposed to onboard National Testing Agency for third edition of Fit India Quiz. It is further proposed that the NTA collects the registration fees Rs 100 per student from the schools directly. No additional amount shall be paid by Fit India Mission.

A separate agenda for engaging National Testing Agency in the third edition of Fit India on nomination basis in accordance with the GFR 194 will be placed before Finance Committee for approval.

### **iii. Execution of National Rounds for Fit India Quiz 2023:**

In the first & second edition of Fit India Quiz, the production and telecast of National Round had been done by Star India Pvt Ltd. The production and telecast partner of Fit India Quiz 2023 is yet to be decided.


