**MINUTES OF THE 52<sup>nd</sup> MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY (GB) OF SPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA (SAI) HELD ON 13.03.2020.**

The 52<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Governing Body (GB) of Sports Authority of India (SAI) was held on 13.03.2020 at 3.00 PM under the Chairmanship of Shri Kiren Rijiju, Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C) for Youth Affairs & Sports at SAI Conference Hall, SAI HQ, New Delhi

The list of participants is placed at Annexure - I.

At the very outset, the Director General, SAI welcomed the Chairman, the Members and all the participants. The Chairman, Governing Body in his opening remarks extended a very warm welcome to all the Members and requested for their valuable contribution. Thereafter, with the permission of the Chair, the Agenda Items were taken up for discussion.

**Agenda Item No. 1:**

**Confirmation of Minutes of the 51<sup>st</sup> Governing Body Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2018**

The Minutes of the 51<sup>st</sup> Governing Body was confirmed.

**Agenda Item No. 2:**

**Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in the 51<sup>st</sup> GB meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2018**

The GB noted the action taken on the decisions taken in the 51<sup>st</sup> GB meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019. However, the following discussions took place on the Action Taken Report:

- On the issue of redevelopment of J.N. Stadium on PPP model, Secretary (Sports) informed that project is being developed in consultation with NITI Aayog for redevelopment of J.N. Stadium in PPP mode keeping in mind that the present sports facilities are not reduced. The RFQs for appointing Consultants is under preparation.

- While discussing the ATR on recruitment of Khelo India/TOPS Secretariat, it was informed in the meeting that a decision has been taken to provide TOPS Secretariat from NSDF instead of SAI block grant. Chairman, Governing Body advised to have suitable nomenclature to reflect their job profile.

#### **Agenda Item No. 3**

#### **Restructuring of SAI Sports Promotional Schemes as National Centre of Excellence**

A presentation on different facilities of NCOE including that of Sports Science Centre was made. Regarding engagement of Scientific Staff (Agenda Item No. 3 (VI) (b)), it was clarified that the posts of Scientific Cadre are being proposed to be created/increased in the restructuring of SAI as mentioned in Agenda Item No.6.

The proposal was approved with a direction to amend existing recruitment/service rules and draft suitable new rules keeping in view the revised structure and needs.

#### **Agenda Item No. 4**

#### **Restructuring of all STC / SAG scheme under SAI Sports Promotional Schemes**

Governing Body took note of the comments received through email from Shri B.V.P. Rao, one of the Members of the Governing Body, who could not attend the meeting.

After deliberation the proposal was approved.

#### **Agenda Item No. 5**

#### **Adoption of Schools under National Sports Talent Contest (NSTC) Akhara Scheme of SAI**

The proposal was ratified.

#### **Agenda Item No. 6**

#### **Cadre Restructuring of Sports Authority of India**

A presentation was made before the Governing Body on the salient points of the proposal. It was informed by JS (Expenditure), Ministry of Finance that since SAI is an autonomous body and the proposed restructuring is a financial neutral proposal, therefore, it can be approved by the Governing Body and reference to Department of Expenditure is not needed.

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Governing Body approved the proposal with a direction to amend existing recruitment/ service rules and draft suitable new rules keeping in view the revised structure and needs. It was desired that the proposal may be forwarded to MYAS.

**Agenda Item no. 7**

**Engagement of man-power on deputation/contract basis**

The proposal at 7 (a) & 7 (b) was approved in view of the urgent need. The GB also took note of proposals at 7 (c) & 7 (d) and also the number of man-power employed in each category. JS&FA, MYAS stated that in future rules should be amended to provide for deputation/contract appointment. For contractual appointment, the period and terms of contract should be fixed and remuneration to be paid on lump-sum basis. If a person, who is already getting higher scale in his parent cadre, applies for a lower scale post on deputation, then his pay and allowances should be fixed in terms of Govt. of India Rules and Regulations. It was decided that the officers already taken on contract/deputation to meet urgent needs should be treated as stop-gap arrangement and RRs be amended at the earliest.

**Agenda Item No. 8**

**Out of Turn Promotion in Coaching Cadre.**

The proposal was ratified.

It was decided that Govt. of India rules/policy regarding out of turn promotion may be examined for adoption in SAI.

**Agenda Item No. 9**

**Amendment in the Recruitment Rule for the post of Assistant Director and appointment of Assistant Directors.**

The proposal was ratified.

**Agenda Item No. 10**

**Revision of wages of contract coaches working in SAI w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2019**

The proposal was ratified.

**Agenda Item No. 11**

**Re-Designation of the Post of Senior and Junior Hindi Translator**

The proposal was ratified.

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**Agenda Item no. 12**

**Procurement of Sports Items for Rural Jaipur**

The proposal was approved.

**Agenda Item no. 13**

**Procurement of Archery Equipment for NCOEs**

The proposal was approved.

**Agenda Item no. 14**

The proposal was approved.

**Agenda Item no. 15**

**Award of Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) for Electronic Target Shooting Systems at Dr. KSSR, New Delhi**

The proposal was ratified. It was decided to explore long term AMC agreement with the vendor in future.

**Empanelment of Sports Agencies specialised in Sports Architectures for SAI infrastructure works**

In view of provisions of GFR 133 (2) and 133 (3), following decisions were taken:

- a. SAI should explore the possibility of itself getting notified for such proposals as indicated in GFR 133 (3)
- b. Till such time work may be executed through existing panel of PSUs.
- c. The PSU panel should also be extended.

In view of advisory on Social Distancing issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, SAI has adopted proactive prevention strategy to protect trainees of SAI from exposure of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19).

Accordingly, the following directions as preventive measures are issued for strict compliance:-

- a) All the training including Academic training being imparted in NCOEs and STCs shall be suspended henceforth with immediate effect until further orders.
- b) The hostel facilities may be kept open till 20. 03. 2020 to avoid any inconvenience to the athletes.
- c) In case any athlete has an exam in coming days he/she may be allowed to stay to take the examination. However adequate care may be taken to ensure that they are not exposed to infection. The SOP issued by the health authorities may be strictly followed.
- d) All National camps shall also be postponed except for those where athletes are being trained as part of Olympics preparation.
- e) The concerned Regional Director in Charge of academic institutions, NCOE, STC will ensure that all trainees are sent back home under intimation to parents following the travel precautions. The centre head should help in making travel arrangements for all trainees. Those trainees of NCOE and STC who have their home town within 400 km of centre should be provided AC-III tier train ticket. For trainees who have to travel more than 400 km should be provided with the air tickets. The concerned Regional Director is hereby authorised to take action accordingly.
- f) No tournaments/ sports functions / seminar & workshops should be held till clearance obtained and restrictions withdrawn by Central/ State authorities.

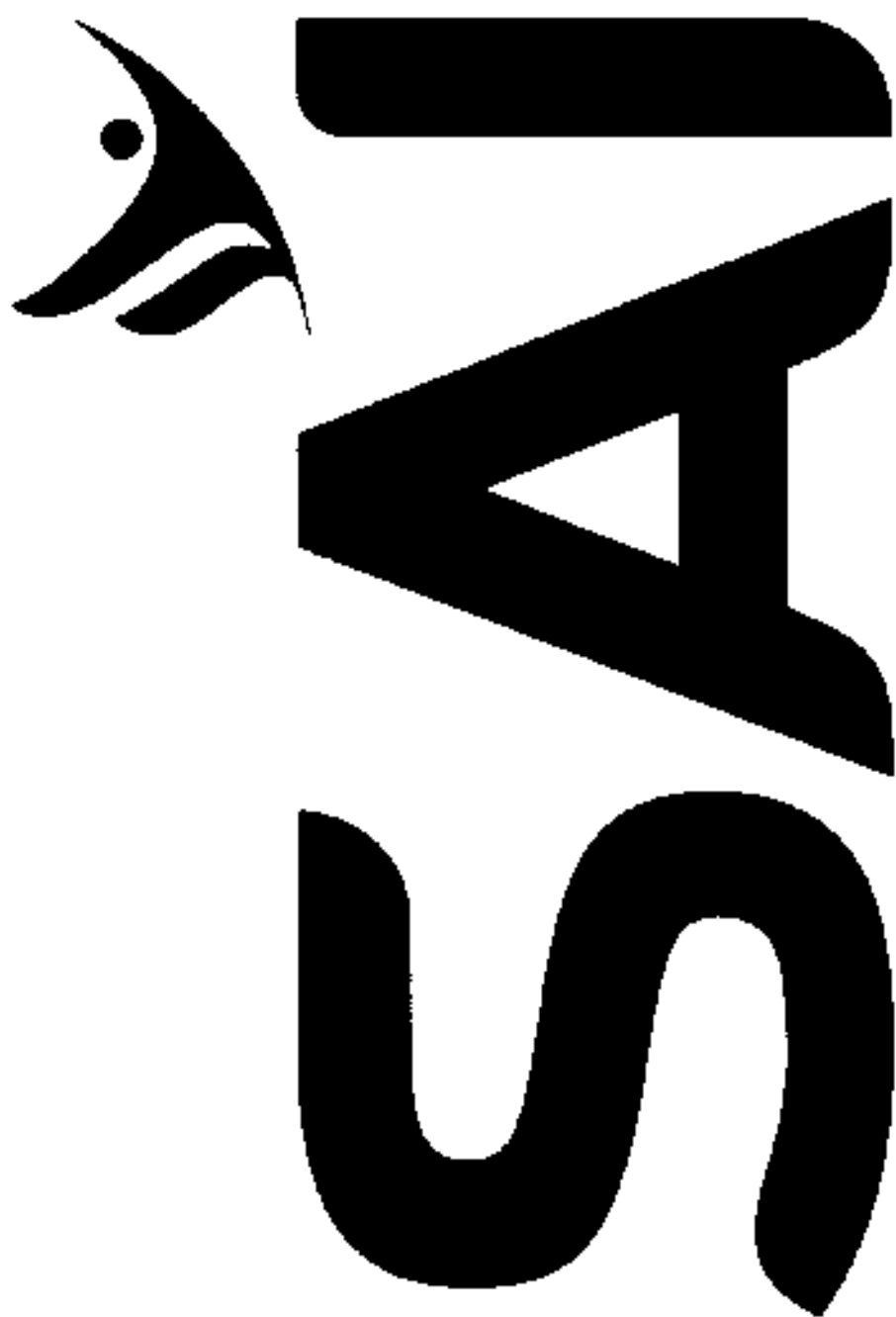

The SAI Centre Bangalore is adjoining to Bangalore University. Director i/c Bangalore stated that Bangalore University had decided to construct a Compound Wall for its Hostel Complex and Mega Mess. The present approach Road to SAI will be closed at 258 meters from the present Main Gate of SAI Campus. The matter was taken up with the Vice Chancellor and The Registrar of Bangalore University, has agreed to allow SAI to construct an alternate approach for access to the SAI Campus- placed at flag 'X'.

The road proposed to be closed by Bangalore University was the Main Road to SAI Campus, which was used by SAI Employees, buses, trucks and heavy duty vehicles. The road is also used by National Campers for Cross Country run. The approach Road existed in the southern side of the campus was very narrow and the Railway Under bridge was of 3.66 mtrs width only, which cannot be widened due to technical safety reasons as explained by the Railway officials. The construction of new alternative approach road is essential and was to be constructed on priority as Bangalore University was planning to close the present road as stated above within two months.

A preliminary estimate had been prepared by NPCC for the work. The detail of the same is given as under :-

- The work is being undertaken by NPCC, which is one of the Central Public Works agencies, empanelled by SA, for undertaking infrastructure development works. The work is to be executed in two phases. In Phase 1 motorable road with all allied works at the total cost of Rs 155.16 lakh and in Phase 2 Laying of Bituminous concrete at the total cost of Rs.66.09 lakh.



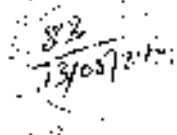
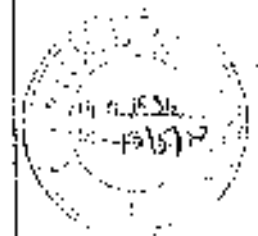

Construction of New Approach Road to SAI NSSC from Bangalore, Phase-I at an estimated cost of Rs. 155.16 Lakhs & Phase-II for Laying of Bituminous macadam and Bituminous concrete over the newly constructed road along with sign boards, road marking etc, amounting to Rs. 66.09 lakh

**Justification**

The SAI Centre Bangalore is adjoining to Bangalore University. Director i/c Bangalore had informed that the Bangalore University had to construct a Compound Wall for its Hostel Complex and Mega Mess and the only approach Road to SAI Complex was being closed. The road closed by Bangalore University was the Main Road to SAI Campus which was used by SAI Employees and for the movement of the players and the stores using buses, trucks and other heavy vehicle for transportation of all store items. The road was also used by National Campers for Cross Country run. The approach Road existing in the southern side of the campus is very narrow and the Railway Under bridge is of 3.66 mtrs width only which cannot be widened due to technical safety reasons as explained by the Railway officials. Therefore, the construction of new alternate approach road was essential and had to be constructed on priority as Bangalore University had planned to close the present road as stated above within two months.

The matter was taken up with the Vice Chancellor and Registrar of Bangalore University who have agreed to allow SAI to construct an alternate approach road for access to the SAI Campus.

The work was awarded to NPCC, a Public Works Organization empanelled with SAI for infrastructure development/creation.

An estimate was submitted by the Construction agency (NPCC) as per details given below:-



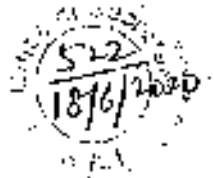

4. The designated committee scrutinized and evaluated the pre-qualification and clarification / shortfall documents uploaded by respective Bidders as per the requirements specified under Clause 6 and 7 of the said RFE. A summary of the documents submitted by them has been prepared and accordingly deliberated upon one by one by the members of the committee.

**5. OBSERVATIONS:**


- i. The Committee thoroughly checked all the documents submitted by the bidders as per the requirements set under Clause 6 and 7 against the said RFE.
- ii. The Committee, while checking the pre-qualification criteria of the 29 [Twenty-Nine] received Bids, observed shortfalls in documents submitted by 24 bidders and accordingly the shortfalls were communicated to the respective bidders for the clarifications.
- iii. The Committee observed that M/s Thomas Cook has submitted that they are not able to provide the average turnover of the company exclusively from professional services viz. events. However, the overall turnover of the company stands at INR 20,000 Cr and above that the bidder has submitted over 19 projects to overcast the strength in conducting events wherein the cost of their largest event stands at INR 6.5 Cr. Also, an undertaking was obtained from the bidder stating that their average turnover from professional services rendered in the field of event management is exceeding INR 20 Crores. The committee was satisfied with the explanation submitted by the bidder.
- iv. After an exhaustive scrutiny of all the relevant shortfall documents and clarifications, the committee found the documents submitted by most of the bidders in order and in substantial conformity with the mandatory/ essential requirements of the tender guidelines. However, while observing the clarifications submitted by M/s 4 Play Films and M/s Digivaarta Pvt Ltd. The committee observed that the clarifications have not been answered to the satisfaction of the committee. Hence, M/s 4 Play Films and Digivaarta Pvt Ltd. are disqualified on account of the non-submission of pre-qualification documents duly mentioned in clause 6-7 of the RFE as per the table below.

Recovery of the amount mentioned at S.No.2 and 3 above has already been made from my salary for the month of July 2005. In this regard, I would like to bring the following points in your kind notice for consideration -

7. The procedure/guidelines to be followed for additions/alterations in the General Pool Residential Accommodation of Central Government at the request of allottee is laid down in Chapter 5 of CPWD Maintenance Manual. The additions/alterations can be carried out at the request of the allottee for which application form is also prescribed. As per the procedure laid down in the CPWD Manual, on receipt of such request from the allottee, proper estimate has to be prepared and an undertaking is required to be obtained from the allottee that she/he undertakes to pay 10%, 20% or 100% of the cost of the additions/alterations of the items. I have not made any such request for additions/alterations to be made in the SAI flat No.673 allotted to me nor I have given any undertaking to pay any amount for this account. A copy of the chapter No.5 of CPWD Maintenance Manual alongwith a copy of Annexure-XI

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containing the Performa for application and Undertaking is enclosed for kind perusal.

8. Under the Rules for Government Residences as contained in FRSR (Part-I) also there is a provision for payment of 10%, 20%, 100% cost of additions/alterations carried out in General Pool Accommodation as well as in the residential accommodation belonging to other Departmental Pools and maintained by CPWD, at the request of the allottee. A copy is enclosed for kind perusal.
9. It is clear from the above provisions that recovery can be made only in respect of repair/maintenance works executed in G.P. accommodation or other departmental pool accommodation if maintained by CPWD and allottee has made request for such additions/alterations and also has given an undertaking to pay the amount. In these cases, SAI accommodation is neither G.P. Accommodation nor maintained by the CPWD and also I have not made any such request. The accommodations of SAI is being maintained by the HK / Infrastructure Division of SAI and not through CPWD. The above-mentioned works were also carried out by SAI in-house.
10. In the letter No.SAI/AE(C)/CM/HK/397/04/398 dated 29.7.05 it is mentioned a sum of Rs.1, 08,958/- towards 10% and 100% share of the allottee in terms of CPWD Maintenance Manual is payable by me in respect of work done during April/May, 2002 by the contractor. The repair / maintenance works in flat No.673 was done by SAI in-house before I shifted to this house as house was not in good condition. Even the calculations made in the statement enclosed to above letter is not correct.
11. It is the demand of the principle of natural justice that before taking a decision to recover any amount from the allottee, his views / comments should have been obtained. In my case, when the intimation regarding the recovery was received by me, SE (Infra) was requested to show me the concerned files which have not been made available. My comments were also not obtained taking a decision to recover the amount and instructions have been issued to DDO.
12. The residential accommodation available in SAI is neither G.P. Accommodation of the Central Govt. nor maintained by CPWD. Therefore, the provisions contained in CPWD Maintenance Manual and FRSR (Part-I) as mentioned above were never followed in SAI. If, it is decided to follow these rules/norms in SAI the same should be made applicable from prospective date and not from the retrospective date in past cases where the works have already been executed.

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These rule positions were brought to the kind notice of Director general, SAI, vide my representation dated 9.8.2005 for reconsideration of the decisions in this regard and to avoid financial hardship to me. However, I have not received any communication from the Office of DG, SAI regarding decision taken on my representation. Sir, I shall be obliged if you could intervene in the matter and give me justice. For this act of your kindness, I will be ever obliged.

Sub: Erroneous recovery on account of repair/maintenance works executed in Flat 673, Asiad Village Complex, New Delhi, allotted to me by SAI.

Sir,

During my tenure of deputation from 2001 to 2005 as Executive Director (Finance) of SAI, I was allotted SAI accommodation, House no 673, Asiad Village Complex, New Delhi in the month of April 2002. Since the house was in bad shape, repair works were carried out by SAI during the year 2002 before it was occupied by me.

Suddenly after 4 years, just before my tenure was going to end, it was informed to me by Asst Director (GA-1), vide letter dated, 29-7-2005 that a sum of Rs. 1,08,958 was payable by me towards the repair and maintenance work done by SAI in its own property. It was highly arbitrary. Immediately I put up a letter addressed to the then Director General, highlighting this arbitrariness and explaining that no such recovery has been made by SAI from any of the officers and employees of SAI towards repair and maintenance of its property from the occupants.

At the time of my relieving, a sum of Rs. 1,00,100 was shown as payable and a sum of Rs. 8,758 was deducted from my salary before issuing the LPC.

In this regard, I would like to bring the following points to your kind notice to take appropriate decision and issue non recovery letter in this regard-

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1. The procedure/guidelines to be followed for additions/alterations in the General Pool residential accommodation of Central Government at the request of the allottee is laid down in Chapter 5 of CPWD Maintenance Manual. The additions/alterations, can be carried out at the request of the allottee for which application form is also prescribed. As per the procedure laid down in the manual, on receipt of such request from the allottee, proper estimate has to be prepared and an undertaking is required to be obtained from the allottee that she/he undertakes to pay 10%, 20% or 100% of the cost of the additions/alterations of the items. I had never made any such request for additions/alterations to be made in the SAI Flat no 673, nor I have given any undertaking to pay any amount on this account.
  2. Under the Rules for Government Residence as contained in FRSR (Part-I) also, there is a provision for payment towards the cost of additions/alterations carried out in General Pool accommodation as well as in the residential accommodation belonging to other departmental pools and maintained by CPWD, at the request of the allottee.
  3. The Accommodation provided to me by the SAI was not General Pool accommodation, but its own property. The repair and maintenance works in flat no 673 was done by SAI, in-house through a contractor, before I occupied the same. That too the repair works were carried out by SAI on its own, not on my request.
  4. The residential accommodation provided to by SAI was neither general pool accommodation of the Central Government nor maintained by CPWD. Therefore, the provisions of CPWD maintenance manual and FRSR as mentioned above are not applicable in my case. Moreover, it was never followed in SAI. If it was decided during that point of time to make it applicable, it should have done from prospective date and not from the retrospective date, for past cases where the repair works have already been executed.
  5. It was demand of the principle of natural justice that before taking any decisions to recover any amount from the allottee, his views/comments should have been obtained. It was never followed.
  6. No such recovery had been made by SAI from any of its employee towards the cost of any repair and maintenance of the residential accommodation provided by SAI. Only I was made exception, which was highly arbitrary in nature.
  7. All these facts were brought to the notice of the then Director General SAI immediately, with a request to take a decision of non recovery in favour of me on this account, but no decision was communicated.

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8. In the light of the above mentioned facts, it is requested that no recovery certificate should be issued in my favour so that undue financial hardship to me is avoided. Waiting for an earliest decision in this regard.
