**Discipline & Category: Taekwondo (Kyorugi Male and Female, Para Kyorugi and Poomsae)**

Sir,

I am directed to convey approval of the Competent Authority for holding of Talent hunt followed by National Coaching Camp towards preparation of Indian Taekwondo players for the Asian Games, 2022.

2. The Talent Hunt will be conducted at 02 locations, as per World Taekwondo (WT) rules and transparency for the WT categories/events as under:

A. **NCOE LUCKNOW**:- Detailed outline enclosed at "Annexure A"

i. **Kyorugi**- (8 WT CATEGORIES from 3<sup>rd</sup> January to 6<sup>th</sup> January 2022)

a. Male: U-54 Kg, U-58 kg, U-63 Kg, U-68 kg, U-74 Kg. U-80 Kg, U-87Kg, Over 87 Kg.

ii. **Para Kyorugi**- (K-44: 6<sup>th</sup> January 2022)

a. Male: U-58 Kg, U-63 kg, U-70 Kg, U-80 Kg, Over-80Kg, (5WT CATEGORIES)

b. Female: U-47 kg, U-52 Kg, U-57 kg, U-65 Kg, Over-65 Kg, (5WT CATEGORIES)

iii. **Poomsae**- (6<sup>th</sup> January 2022)

a. Individual Event: Male & Female (U- 30 Yrs.)

b. Team Event: Male & Female (U-30 Yrs.)

B. **NCOE, LNCPE, THIRUVANANTHPURAM**:- (10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2022- detailed outline enclosed at Annexure B

i. **Kyorugi** –

a. Female: U-46 Kg, U-49 kg, U-53 Kg, U-57 kg, U-62 Kg, U-67 Kg, U-73Kg, Over 73 Kg.

3. The eligibility criteria for appearing in the Talent Hunt is as under:

A. **Kyorugi**-

i. Indian athletes in WORLD TAEKWONDO ranking list –between 01 to 150 as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 or medalist of any WT recognized championship since 2018.

ii. All Medalists of scheduled National championships organized by any faction in Cadet Junior and Senior categories since 2018 including School National Games (SGFI) and All India University Games WHO are of the age of 17 yrs or above/ born in 2004 or earlier.

B. **Para Kyorugi**-

i. Indian athletes in WORLD TAEKWONDO ranking list (K-43& K-44)

ii. All Medalists in scheduled National Championships in Sr. categories since 2018 (K-43& K-44).

**C. Poomsae -U -30 yrs-**


- i. Medalists of WT recognized competitions (including online) but below 30 yrs of age i.e. born in 1993 or after.
  - ii. Medalists of South Asian Games (SAG), 2019.
  - iii. Medalists of scheduled national championships organized by any faction in Cadet, Junior and Senior categories since 2018.

6. TA/DA to SAI officials will be borne by respective Regional Centres, however Non SAI Officials will be required to be paid TA/DA at the talent hunt trial/camp venue.
7. No TA/DA is admissible for the athletes attending talent Hunt trials, however post selection TA/DA, is admissible for joining camp venue as per rules along with training, lodging boarding, insurance, kit etc.
8. Post talent hunt, a preparatory camp will be held for selected players from 16<sup>th</sup> January 2022 onwards in SAI NCOE Centres till March 2022 as under:
  - a. Male Kyourgi, Para Kyourgi (both Male and Female) and Poomsae (male and Female) at NCOE, Lucknow.
  - b. Female Kyourgi at NCOE, Thiruvanthapuram.
9. Expenditure for boarding, lodging, food supplements, TA, local transport, sports kit, insurance for the said activity are to be booked under the budget for ACTC as per the norms of National Coaching Camp.
10. Medical as per actual.
11. Please ensure that SOP issued by SAI and MHA guidelines for COVID-19 are strictly adhered to.
12. List of selected athletes for the National Coaching Camp should be forwarded to TEAMS DIVISION after commencement of the Talent Hunt/ trials by the coach.
13. The expenditure may be debited under the head "General Assistance for holding Coaching Camp (Head 49.0500).
14. The monitoring of attendance on daily basis shall be maintained by the coach in the National Coaching Camp.

16. The financial implications for the National Coaching Camp are as follows:
  - a. Boarding for 102 campers (94 Athletes + 02 Foreign Coach + 04 Indian Coach + 02 Support Staff) @Rs. 31/- per person per day.
  - b. Lodging for 102 campers (94 Athletes + 02 Foreign Coach + 04 Indian Coach + 02 Support Staff) @Rs. 690/- per person per day.
  - c. Food supplements to 94 players @Rs. 430/- per athlete per day.
  - d. Sports kit @Rs. 20,000/- per person to be provided by Executive Director, SAI NCOE Lucknow and NCOE LNCPE, Thiruvananthapuram only to those campers who have not received it in earlier camp in the year 2021-22.
  - e. Travelling as per actual as per norms.
  - f. Insurance for 102 campers (94 Athletes + 02 Foreign Coach + 04 Indian Coach + 02 Support Staff) as per norms by SAI HQ, New Delhi.
  - g. RT-PCR test as per SOP as per actual.
  - h. Following Sports equipment as approved in the ACTC 2021-22 may also be procured following the due procedure:
