

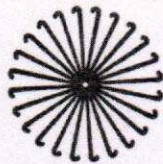

HOCKEY INDIA

Hockey India (HI) is the National Sports Federation for the sport of Hockey in India. Hockey India is affiliated to the International Hockey Federation, Asian Hockey Federation and Indian Olympic Association.

Hockey India has the responsibility to develop and manage the national teams programmes and works in close coordination with the Sports Authority of India (SAI) in the delivery of the national teams programmes across senior and junior hockey.

SPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA

The Sports Authority of India (SAI) is a body set up by the Government of India. The objectives of SAI are to promote and broad-base sports in the country and to implement schemes/programmes for achieving excellence in sports in different disciplines at international level in order to establish India as a major sporting power. It also act as an interface between the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and other agencies concerned with the promotion/ development of sports in the country on the other hand, i.e., State Govt., U.T. Administration, IOA, National Sports Federations, Sports Control Boards, Industrial Houses, etc.

ROLE SUMMARY

Reporting to the High Performance Director, Hockey India and the Indian Junior Women Hockey Team Chief Coach, the Scientific Advisor will be responsible for the physical preparation of the Junior Women Athletes leading the national junior women team to the Junior Women World Cup 2020, with a view to achieving success.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. REPORTING AND COMMUNICATION

This position also works closely with:

- Hockey India management team and Executive Board
- Coaches and support staff for senior, junior women and sub junior women
- Sports Authority of India
- Sports Authority of India Centre staff
- High Performance and Development Committee members
- Hockey India Selection Committee

The Scientific Advisor will be required to submit regular reports to management on the physical status of the national teams and core probable programme activities plans.

2. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be responsible for the Physical preparation of the Indian National Junior Women Squad, and individual team members.
- Monitor and evaluate athlete performance monthly using relevant testing to ensure standards are met and potential is maximised.
- Utilise coaches throughout the system to assist with the monitoring and physical development of athletes in the regions.
- Design a periodised training program that accounts for domestic and international tournaments.

- Liaise with Sub-Junior, Scientific Advisor to ensure compatibility in training methods and procedures.
- Work with the Masseur and Physiotherapist to ensure recovery procedures are in place.
- Drive the provision of support services to the team, squad and individuals.
- Provide physical direction for the Indian National Junior Programme.
- Help the development of performance culture and leadership within the squad.
- Supervise injury rehabilitation sessions to ensure successful transition from injury to practice

3. ADMINISTRATION

- Provide monthly written reports and KPI data to the High Performance Director, Coach Indian Junior Women Hockey Team and Hockey India Management following all international events as well as providing programme reports as required.
- Conduct other duties as directed by Director High Performance, CEO, Hockey India Executive Board or Sports Authority of India.
- Provide orders for supplements and advance of every camp / tour.

4. QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

- Minimum undergraduate degree in sport science or Level II Strength and Conditioning
- Experience of successful performance achievements at the elite level
- Experience and proven capability in the physical conditioning of athletes.
- Demonstrated experience in planning, organising and implementing a comprehensive high performance coaching programme for elite level teams and athletes.
- Knowledge of leading trends in performance coaching, including coaching science, practices and the appropriate application of leading technology tools.
- The ability to attain excellence from players through the establishment of a 'winning' culture.
- Effective management skills that reflect your ability to build and successfully implement long-term strategic plans that are supported by informed operational decisions.
