2.0 Scope of Work

The scope of work shall include but not limited to Site investigation, preparation of Comprehensive scope and specification in consultation with PMU (Project Management Unit)/Committee appointed for the project, Topographic Survey, Soil Investigation, preparation, and approval of the architectural plan from SAI HO. Preparation of preliminary estimate based on CPWD SOR/PAR and once approved submission of preliminary project report/Detailed Project Report as demanded & design brief report.

Detailed scope of work shall be specified by SAI during the invitation of Financial/Commercial Bid from the empaneled Architecture Firm/Agencies.

3.0 Eligibility Criteria for Empanelment

- 3.1 The participating Architectural firm/agency must fulling either of the below mentioned criteria:
 - a. The Architects representing the Architecture firm should be a member of (i) Council of Architecture or (ii) Indian Institute of Architecture or (iii) Institute of Engineers.
 - b. The Architectural Firm (proprietorship) should be registered with Council of Architecture.
 - c. If the firm is a partnership firm or limited company then at least one partner/director shall be registered with Council of Architecture.
- 3.2 The Architecture Firms/Agencies should have minimum of **five years' experience** in providing consultancy services in sports infrastructure related projects on the date of submission of the offer.

The Copies of award of work/MoU by client must be enclosed

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 along with the RFE as proof.
 - 3.3 Architecture Firms/Agencies should have experience of consultancy services for at least **five works costing for a minimum contract value of INR 5 crore each** related to <u>similar</u> infrastructure or project_-in the last 10 years.

The Completion Certificate along with Award of work/MoU highlighting the cost of the project, duly signed by the client/employer should be submitted with the RFE.

- *Similar infrastructure of projects shall mean Agency must have executed Projects in the role of Project consultant cum architect or equivalent for construction of Residential/Hostel/Academic Building/Institutional campus/Sports complex/High Performance center / Indoor Stadium/ Stadium Development works/ Office Building/interior Design of Buildings
- 3.4 The Architecture Firms/Agencies should have an average annual turnover from the consultancy job only of INR 1 Crore during the last five years from the date of submission of the bid.
 - A Certificate from Chartered Accountant to be submitted to substantiate the Annual Turnover.
- 3.5 The Architecture Firms/Agencies should have min. balance of Rs.50 lakhs in the bank account (including Fixed Deposit) and should not have been declared as insolvent by the competent authorities.
 - A Recent Certificate not less than one month old (from the date of submission bids) to been closed from the banker to be submitted.
- 3.6 The Architecture Firms /Agencies should not have been blacklisted / stand debarred as on the date of submission of the bid by any Govt./PSU/Autonomous body/any registered body.
 - A Self undertaking to be submitted by the bidder duly sealed and signed by authorized signatory.

4.0 Terms of Shortlisting of Architectural Firm/Agencies.

- 4.1 SAI will examine the Bids to determine whether they are complete, the uploaded documents have been properly signed; supporting papers/documents attached and the Bids are generally in order etc.
- 4.2 SAI may, at its sole discretion, waive any minor infirmity, non-conformity or irregularity in a Bid which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such a waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.
- 4.3 Architecture Firms/Agencies shortlisted based on eligibility criteria will be evaluated as per parameters given below, only those firms who score 75 marks out of 100 will qualify for being shortlisted for the empanelment:

- 4.4 The bids received from the firms would be evaluated on the basis of their Minimum eligibility criteria competencies. Only the firms having the requisite qualifying technical score would be eligible for being empaneled.
- 4.5 Further, empanelment does not assure that purchase/work order will be issued to the consultant/Architects/Architectural firms. Separate Commercial tenders/quotation will be asked from empaneled vendors only as and when required.
- 4.6 No Architecture Firms/Agencies or its Associate shall submit more than one Proposal, in response to this RFE. Architecture Firms/Agencies applying individually or as an Associate shall not be entitled to submit another Proposal

5.0 Instructions to Bidders for Formulation & Submission of RFE

5.1 General Instruction

a) The Architecture Firms/Agencies can download this RFE from the website: http://sportsauthorityofindia.nic.in & CPP Portal website: http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app. Subsequently, the bid must be prepared and submitted ONLINE ONLY as per the Bid Schedule as

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 specified in this RFE.
 - b) No Architecture Firms/Agencies or its Associate shall submit more than one Proposal, in response to this RFE. Architecture Firms/Agencies applying individually or as an Associate shall not be entitled to submit another Proposal.
 - c) All the documents are to be mandatorily uploaded online as per the instruction for online bid submission detailed in this RFE document.
 - e) **Definitions and Abbreviations:** The following definitions and abbreviations, which have been used in these documents shall have the meanings as indicated below:
 - i. **Purchaser'** means the organization purchasing services as incorporated in this document i.e., Sports Authority of India (SAI).
 - ii. **Bid'** (including the term 'tender', 'offer', 'quotation' or 'proposal' in certain contexts) means an offer-to-offer services in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this RFE.
 - iii. 'Agency', 'Firm', 'Company', 'Applicant', 'Consultant', and 'Service Provider' means any registered entity or person or associations of persons who submit their proposals for providing Services in accordance with this RFE.
 - iv. **Services** means services as mentioned in this document and other such obligations of the supplier covered under the contract.
 - v. **Terms of Reference (TOR)** means the document included in the RFE which explains the scope of work, activities, and tasks to be performed.

- vi. 'Notification of Award' or 'NOA' means the letter issued by SAI to the Successful Applicant to undertake and execute the project in conformity to the terms and conditions set forth in the RFE and any subsequent amendments thereof.
- vii. 'Contract' means the written agreement entered between the purchaser and the supplier, together with all the documents mentioned therein and including all attachments, annexures etc., therein.
- viii. **'LoA'** means the Letter of Acceptance issued by Sports Authority of India for the purpose as mentioned in this document.
- ix. 'Party' means the Client or the Applicant and 'Parties' means both of them.
- x. 'RFE' means this Request for Empanelment issued by Sports Authority of India for the purpose as mentioned in this document.
- xi. **Performance Security/Security Deposit** 'means monetary or financial guarantee to be furnished by the successful Applicant for due performance of the contract placed on it. Performance Security is also known as interest free Security Deposit.

5.2 Language of Bid

The Bid submitted by the Architecture Firms/Agencies (herein after as Applicant) and all subsequent correspondence(s) and documents relating to the

Bid exchanged between the Applicant and SAI, shall be written in the English language. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by the Applicant in connection with its Bid may be written in any other

language provided the same is accompanied by an English translation and, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, notarized English translation shall prevail.

5.3 **Documents to be submitted**

All the documents are to be mandatorily uploaded online as per the instruction for online bid submission detailed in this RFE document.

5.4 **BID Validity**

- 5.4.1 The Bid shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of **180 days** (One hundred eighty days) after the date of Bid opening prescribed in the Bidding Document. Any Bid valid for a shorter period shall be treated as unresponsive and rejected. On completion of the validity period, unless the Applicant withdraws the Bid in writing, it will be deemed to be valid until such time that the Applicant formally (in writing) withdraws the same.
- 5.4.2 In exceptional cases, the Applicants may be requested to extend the validity of their Bids up to a specified period by SAI. The Applicants, who agree to extend the Bid validity, are to extend the same without any change or modification of their original Bid.
- 5.4.3 In case the day up to which the Bids are to remain valid falls on or subsequently declared a holiday or closed day for SAI, the Bid validity shall automatically be extended up to the next working day.

However, SAI makes no representation or warranty as to the completeness or accuracy of any response, nor does SAI undertake to answer all the queries that have been posed by the Applicants. All responses given by SAI will be distributed/mailed to all the Applicants or posted on the online portal/website. Applicant should regularly visit the portal for any

- 5.5.3 For the purpose of clarification of doubts of the Bidders on issues related to this RFE, SAI intends to hold a Pre-Bid Conference (virtual), scheduled on the date and time as indicated in the RFE Bid schedule. The Applicant or its authorized representatives may attend the pre-bid conference at their own cost. The purpose of the conference is to provide the Applicants with information regarding the RFE and discuss the Applicant's queries, together with proposed solutions. SAI shall provide each Applicant with an opportunity to seek clarifications regarding any aspect of the RFE during the pre-bid conference. The link shall be provided to the Applicants one hour prior to the scheduled meet.
- 5.5.4 Within reasonable period from the Pre-Bid Conference, SAI will issue responses to the entire applicants" written queries, together with any other revised documents (if required).
- 5.5.5 It may be noted that no further queries of any Bidder shall be entertained after the Pre-Bid meeting. Clarifications on queries will be given in the Pre-Bid meeting itself.
- 5.5.6 Amendments to Bidding /RFE Documents:

- 5.6.5 **Late Bids**: Bids received after the specified date and time of receipt of the Bid as mentioned in the Bid schedule indicated in "Important Bid Details & Data Sheet" Section shall not be considered.

 - 5.6.8 **Erasures or Alterations:** The Bids submitted must be without any overwriting, interlineations, interpolation, corrections, double typing, etc. The offers containing erasures or alterations may not be considered. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting in technical Bids may be considered at the discretion of SAI only if they are initialed by the person signing the Bids.
 - 5.6.9 Applicants must ensure that the Technical Bid soft copies do not contain any Commercial items/prices.
 - 5.6.10 All terms and conditions in the bid document shall stand frozen on the date of opening of the bid.
 - 5.6.11 The proof of work orders for claim of relevant experience should be dated on or after the date of registration of the firm/company/LLP etc.
 - 5.6.12 All the pages of the RFE document should be signed with date and seal of the organization should be affixed near the signature of the authorized signatory on all pages. RFE submitted by the bidder will remain valid for acceptance for a period 60 days.
 - 5.6.13 The Architecture Firms/ Agencies shall bear all cost associated with the preparation and submission of their proposals. SAI is not bound to accept any proposal and reserves the right to annul the selection process at any time, without thereby incurring any liability in any
